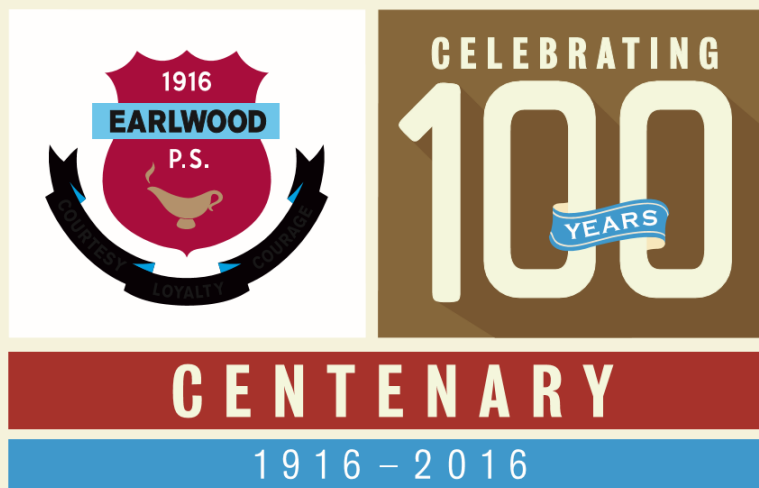

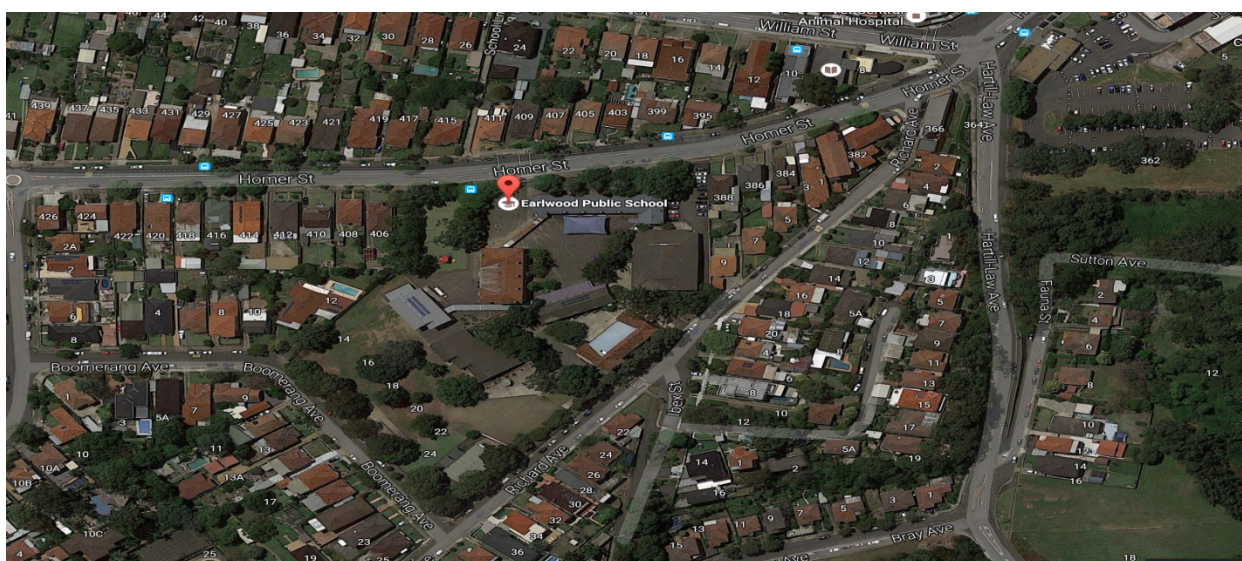

Parking

On the day parking is limited. **There is no onsite parking.** Parking can be found on Homer St, Richard Ave, Boomerang Ave and Morgan St. There is a 'no parking zone' on Homer St approximately 10m from the school gates that can be utilized as a drop off and pick up zone, stopping in this zone is restricted to two minutes. When parking please be mindful of our neighbours.

There is a public carpark situated at the old Earlowd Terminus entry via Homer St.
